3.4 Graduation Ceremony

The Board believes that completion of the requirements for a Dogwood Diploma from the British Columbia school system is a significant achievement. The Board wishes to recognize this achievement in a publicly celebrated graduation ceremony that demonstrates its importance and value.

Only students meeting provincial graduation requirements will participate in the graduation ceremony. Students who are passing the required subjects for graduation or who are obtaining a school completion certificate based on requirements outlined in an Individual Education Plan will be eligible to participate in the graduation ceremony. The Principal will inform students and families if a student is in jeopardy of not being eligible to participate in the graduation ceremony because of failure to meet the requirements. No student shall be excluded from the graduation ceremony because of the inability to pay fees.

Responsibility for the graduation ceremony, including planning, is with the Principal of the school who will consult parents, staff and students. The graduation ceremony shall be held immediately after the last Provincial exam in June.
