7.2 EXPECTATIONS OF STUDENTS ACCESSING TRANSPORTATION

The Board views the school district transportation system as an extension of the school therefore conduct expectations for students riding school buses will be similar to the expectations of each school. Rules and regulations concerning safety and deportment shall be communicated to parents.

Guidelines

1. Principals and bus drivers have prime responsibility for addressing the conduct of students being transported to/from school on school buses. Parents shall be advised by the Principal of incidences when behaviour expectations are not met.
2. Students will not be picked up or dropped at any other point than a regular stop or the school.
3. Principals have the authority to suspend the right to ride buses. Any suspension by the Principal shall be reported to the parents and the Board in accordance with the School Act.
4. Teachers or coaches will be responsible for direct supervision of students during co/extra-curricular trips. The bus driver has paramount authority in matters dealing with the safe operation of the bus.
