SCHOOL ORGANIZATION REPORT  
2011/2012**

This report is prepared in accordance with Section 76.3 of the School Act.

Throughout May, June, August and September, the Principals, the District Principal – Support Services and the Superintendent developed, reviewed and adjusted school organization plans. During this period, classroom teacher allocations, non-enrolling teacher allocations (Resource Teacher and Learning Assistance Teacher) and CUPE support staff allocations (Educational Assistant and Personal Care Attendant) were established, reviewed and enhanced to support student learning at each school in the district.

**Class Size Averages**

The School Act requires a Board to ensure that class sizes meet the following:

Class size

- 76.1** (1) A board must ensure that the average size of its classes, in the aggregate, does not exceed
- (a) for kindergarten, 19 students,
  - (b) for grades 1 to 3, 21 students,
  - (c) for grades 4 to 7, 28 students, and
  - (d) for grades 8 to 12, 30 students.
- (2) Despite subsection (1), a board must ensure that the size of any primary grades class in any school in its school district does not exceed
- (a) for kindergarten, 22 students, and
  - (b) for grades 1 to 3, 24 students.
- (2.1) Despite subsection (1) but subject to subsection (2.4), a board must ensure that the size of any class for any of grades 4 to 7 in any school in its school district does not exceed 30 students unless
- (a) in the opinions of the superintendent of schools for the school district and the principal of the school, the organization of the class is appropriate for student learning, and
  - (b) the principal of the school has obtained the consent of the teacher of that class.
- (2.2) Despite subsection (1) but subject to subsection (2.4), a board must ensure that the size of any class for any of grades 8 to 12 in any school in its school district does not exceed 30 students unless
- (a) in the opinions of the superintendent of schools for the school district and the principal of the school, the organization of the class is appropriate for student learning, and
  - (b) the principal of the school has consulted with the teacher of that class.

Listed overleaf is a summary of the class size averages in our district. They are current to September 28<sup>th</sup>, 2011.

Superfit 11/12	31	All students who requested the course were accommodated, having given consideration to the instructors' input.	

## School Organization Report cont.

### Class Organization

The School Act states that:

- 76.1 (2.3)** Despite subsections (1) to (2.2) but subject to subsection (2.4), a board must ensure that any class in any school in its school district does not have more than 3 students with an individual education plan unless
- (a) in the opinions of the superintendent of schools for the school district and the principal of the school, the organization of the class is appropriate for student learning, and
  - (b) the principal of the school has consulted with the teacher of that class.

These elementary organization plans are current to September 28<sup>th</sup>.
