4.7 Facilities

The Board of Education believes that quality educational school facilities enhance student learning. School facilities reflect the value a community places on education, therefore, facilities and grounds will be safe, well-kept and functional. The cosmetic use of pesticides is prohibited on all district property.

The Board endorses the community use of school district facilities if such use does not conflict with school use, is suited to the facility available, does not require specialized training, aligns with the District's Mission, Vision and Values, and is approved by the Principal / Supervisor.

The Board recognizes the importance of Early Learning programs and services and the significant impact on our students as they transition to school; and supports the use of facilities for Early Learning programs and services.

The costs associated with the community use of school facilities will be offset by the "Schedule of Rental Fees" as outlined in the "Application for Rental of School Facilities" available at the School Board Office.
