6.13 Volunteers

The Board recognizes and values the contributions of the volunteers to the school community.

The *School Act* specifies that a community member may volunteer services at, or for a school. The Board provides the following guidelines regarding volunteer services.

<u>Guidelines</u>

- 1. Volunteers will not be given duties involving confidential information and will be screened by the principal for general suitability.
- 2. Concerns regarding volunteers will be handled by a supervising teacher or the school principal.
- 3. Should the principal determine that a volunteer is unsuitable, the volunteer will be notified that their service is no longer required.
- 4. Where an incident or accident occurs that may conceivably give rise to a claim against a volunteer or the school board, the volunteer must promptly provide all information to the school enabling the school to inform its insurers. Failure to do so may prejudice coverage.
- 5. Overnight trips will require a Police Information Check for volunteers.

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
