## **Policy Manual**

## 7.2 Expectations of Students Accessing Transportation

The Revelstoke Board of Education views the transportation system as an extension of the school and therefore school codes of conduct apply.

## <u>Guidelines</u>

- 1. Bus Drivers, under the supervision of the Manager of Operations and School Principals have the prime responsibility for supporting the conduct of students while safely being transported to/from school, on school buses.
- 2. District staff will annually review, update, and distribute safety information to parents and students.
- 3. To ensure safety, students will not be picked up or dropped at any point other than a designated bus stop or the school.
- 4. Principals have the authority to suspend student access to transportation. Any suspension of this privilege by the Principal shall be reported to the parents and the Board in accordance with the *School Act*.
- 5. Teachers or coaches are responsible for the direct supervision of students during co/extra-curricular trips. The driver has paramount authority in matters dealing with the safe operation of the vehicle.

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
