7.6 Non-Resident and International Students

The Revelstoke Board of Education believes that non-resident and international students should have the opportunity for enrolment in the school district provided they meet criteria regarding placement and subject to the following guidelines.

Guidelines

- 1. A non-resident student shall be defined as one whose parent/guardian is not ordinarily resident in the Province of British Columbia.
- 2. Non-resident students will not be registered at schools without the authorization of the Superintendent of Schools.
- 3. The Superintendent of Schools will only authorize registration of such students if the applicant meets the educational and age requirements regarding the desired placement.
- 4. Non-resident students and International Students shall be allowed to attend school in School District No. 19 (Revelstoke) subject to space being available and subject to an annual tuition payment not less than the provincial per student block funding for English language speaking students and an additional annual tuition payment for any student who requires extra language support. Tuition may be pro-rated for applications for less than full-time study. The additional fees for non-English speaking students are to provide services in the area of language development that will be assessed in consultation with the applicant. Non-resident students will be expected to pay all activity fees, if applicable, and deposits.
- 5. The Revelstoke Board of Education supports and encourages admission of international students. School District No. 19 (Revelstoke) has a partnership with School District 6 (Rocky Mountain) to provide the full range of services necessary to support International students enrolled in Revelstoke schools.

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
