4.7 Facilities

The Board of Education recognizes the importance of quality educational facilities in enhancing student learning. School facilities and grounds reflect the value our community places on education. As such, all District properties will be kept safe, functional, and in good condition. To support environmental sustainability, the cosmetic use of pesticides is strictly prohibited on District property.

The Board supports the community use of school district facilities, provided that:

- It does not conflict with school operations or activities.
- The use is appropriate for the available facility and does not require specialized training.
- It aligns with the District's goals, and Guiding Principles.
- Approval is granted by the Principal/Supervisor or Secretary Treasurer

The Board also recognizes the critical role of Early Learning programs in supporting transition to school for young learners. The use of school district facilities for Early Learning programs and services is fully supported.

To help offset the costs of community use, rental fees will be charged in accordance with the "Schedule of Rental Fees" outlined in the "Application for Rental of School Facilities" available at the School Board Office.
