3.2 Home Schooling Support

The Revelstoke Board of Education offers a wide variety of quality program options in our school settings. This setting is viewed as the most suitable for students to pursue their education. For students who wish to pursue studies outside of Revelstoke Schools, because of preference or particular circumstances, home schooling may be a possible option. As outlined in Ministry policy, the Board offers limited support to home schooled students.

Guidelines

The school principal will register the child of any caregiver who wishes their child to be educated at home.

At the request of a caregiver, home-schooled students may access:

- Evaluation and assessment services to determine the child's educational progress in relation to students of similar age and ability.
- Available educational resource materials to support the child to pursue their educational program.
