4.15 Property Control Bylaw

A bylaw to regulate and control the use of property owned or administered by the Board of Education of School District No. 19 (Revelstoke).

WHEREAS in accordance with the provisions of the School Act, the Board is empowered to make bylaws for the control and regulation of property owned or administered by the Board;

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of Education of School District No. 19 (Revelstoke) enacts as follows:

1. No person shall drive any motor vehicle on any land owned or administered by the Board of Education of School District No. 19 (Revelstoke) except:

- 1.1. on designated roadways, parking and traffic areas; or
- 1.2. for special purposes where permission has been granted by the Superintendent.

2. In utilizing Board property, no person shall:

2.1. Parking

Park or otherwise leave unattended a motor vehicle upon land owned or administered by the Board except in an area set aside for parking. In special circumstances, permission may be granted by the Superintendent. Cars parked in unauthorized areas may be towed at the owner's expense.

2.2. Idling

Cause or permit a motor vehicle to idle for more than three (3) consecutive minutes.

2.3. Trespassing

Enter any property owned or administered by the Board except registered students, parents or guardians of such students, employees, and other persons authorized to be on Board property.

Refuse to leave any property owned or administered by the Board when requested to do so.

2.4. Night Trespass

Trespass or loiter upon any land owned or administered by the Board during nighttime hours.

2.5. Animals

Fail to remove an animal when requested.

2.6. Litter

Throw, deposit, drop, or leave any glass, bottle, can, container, paper, food, garbage or litter on Board property, except in designated receptacles.

2.7. Drugs and/or Alcohol

Bring onto or use on school district property, any alcohol or illegal substances.

3. The provisions of this bylaw shall not restrict the enforcement of the *School Act*, the *Motor Vehicle Act*, or regulations pursuant thereto, or by-laws made by a local Municipal Authority.
4. Except as otherwise provided in this by-law, any person contravening or committing any breach of, or committing any offence against any of the provisions of this bylaw, or who refuses, omits or neglects to fulfill, observe, carry

out or perform any duty, obligation, matter or thing whatsoever by this bylaw prescribed or imposed or required to be done, is liable, *to the full extent of the law*.

This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the Property Control By-law and is in all respects in accordance with the provisions of the *School Act*.
